

Alternative School Program Guidelines

The Board shall operate an alternative school program for students in grades 3-9 who have been suspended or expelled from regular school programs. Attendance in alternative school programs shall be mandatory, and students attending an alternative school shall provide their own transportation. Teachers in alternative schools shall be certificated and shall be selected on the basis of interest and ability to work in alternative situations. Student-teacher ratios shall be small enough to allow for adequate instruction but shall be determined by the age, behavior and academic achievement of students in the program. Textbooks, equipment and supplies shall be provided by the home school. Parents will be notified of student placement in Alternative School. Students are to report to Westwood Junior High no later than 8:00 AM and will be dismissed at 3:00 PM.
