

**Gateway Exams
Administrative Procedure**

1. The Gateway Algebra I Exam will count as 15% of the second semester grade: Students who score at least a proficiency rating will earn a grade of 100 as 15% of their second semester grade. Students who score below proficiency will earn a grade of 69 as 15% of their second semester grade.
2. Students who pass the Gateway Algebra I Exam but fail the Algebra I course must retake the Algebra I course. The passing grade on the Gateway Algebra I Exam will stand as the State requirement for high school diploma but students must retake the Gateway Algebra I Exam as part of the course grade.
3. Students who fail the Gateway Algebra I Exam but pass the Algebra I course must have school/parent/consensus in a decision among three remediation alternatives:
 - The student may progress to Algebra II, but additional preparation for the next administration of the Gateway Algebra I Exam based upon student need must be offered. (State Department of Education Recommendation)
 - The student may retake Algebra I with additional preparation for the next administration of the Gateway Algebra I based upon student need.
 - The student may register for Foundations Math II as remediative course work, either in conjunction with Algebra II or before registering for Algebra II
